

## What are direct payments?

	T
Oirect Payment	A direct payment is money you can get to pay for your care and support, that has been agreed in your support plan, instead of the council arranging this for you.
	Your social care worker will talk to you to understand what matters to you and agree what support you need. We call this a Care Act 2014 Assessment.  They will help look at the different types of support in your area to find the right one for you.
	If you need support that has to be paid for, your social care worker will agree how much money you can get- this is called a 'Personal Budget'.
	You can choose the support you want and have control over who supports you.  You can use the payments to be more independent and you will have responsibility to look after your payments.
	You can get help to look after your direct payments.

Direct Payment	What can you use a direct payment for? Examples of how direct payments have been used in Doncaster in the past are below.
	✓ To employ a Personal Assistant (PA) to help you with your personal care.
	✓ To provide respite for your carer.
	✓ To access social activities.
	✓ To accompany you and support with shopping or domestic tasks.
	✓ To support to carry out parenting duties.



	<ul> <li>Why choose a direct payment?</li> <li>You can be more independent.</li> <li>You have more control in your life, by choosing the time you need support.</li> <li>You can make your own decisions.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>You choose who helps you manage your money.</li> <li>You decide who gives you the support you need.</li> </ul>

Direct Payment	If you are eligible for support, you could choose to receive this as a direct payment (with support if you need it).



CASH CARD  1234 5678 9012 3456  Your Name	You can have the direct payment paid onto a direct payment card.  You will have a card which is like a bank payment card.
	You manage this money and use it to buy your support.  It is not a credit card – you cannot get into debt.
YourBank Statement	You can also have the direct payment sent to a company who can manage it on your behalf.  They will manage this money and use it to pay for your support.
NATIONAL BANK	Will I need to pay anything myself? You will be a given a financial assessment first. Then you may be asked to pay for some of the services.
Anny a	What do direct payments involve?  Most people can manage a direct payment with the right support and information.
Support	Your money is to help make your life better and your social care worker will plan the support you need to make this happen.



Receipt	You will need to keep receipts to show how you have spent money on your direct payments.
